

Did I see a rabbit around here?

Here's a rabbit pattern for you to adapt.

Start with stiff cardboard, or, if you have it, an interfacing material like flexifirm.

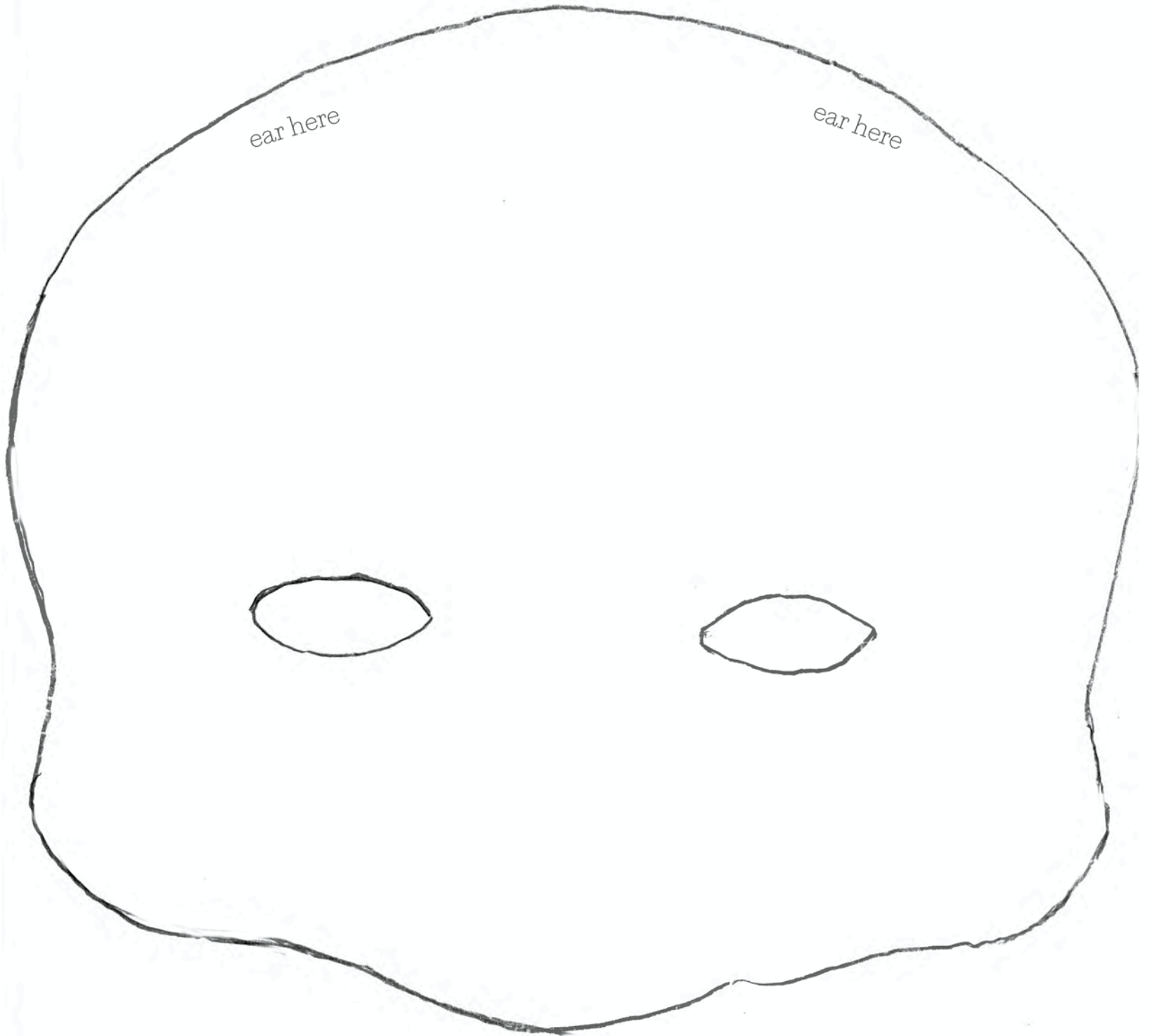
Colour and accessorize—we added eyebrows, eyelids and whiskers to ours.



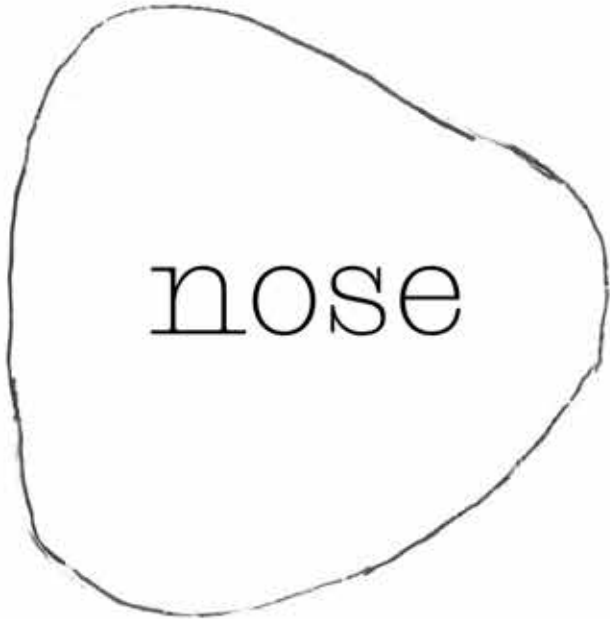
No!

Cut out the eyes,
colour in the
cheeks, eyelids
and eyebrows.

Holes can be
punched near
the temples for
straps. You can
add some tape to
reinforce them.



Tape or glue these parts to the main mask.



The nose is optional, you can just colour for the nose, or glue on a pompom.



You can cut out some strips for whiskers too.

The inside of the ears can be coloured in. You can cut a dart along the dotted line and fold the ears a bit before you attach them if you like.
