CHILDREN'S SEATING: Children should sit on the floor in this centre area. The children are asked to sit cross-legged, rather than kneeling or sitting up.

People with
younger children
can sit on the side,
with the child at
their feet.

ABOUT CHAIRS: Chairs for adults can be arranged along the outside of the children's area, angled towards the performance area. If more chairs are needed for adults, chairs can be arranged in pairs along the sides, and if that isn't sufficient, one or two rows can be set out at the back.

Children should sit on the floor; they'll see better, and remain more involved. Very young children should sit on laps, or on the floor with their parents seated nearby.

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
