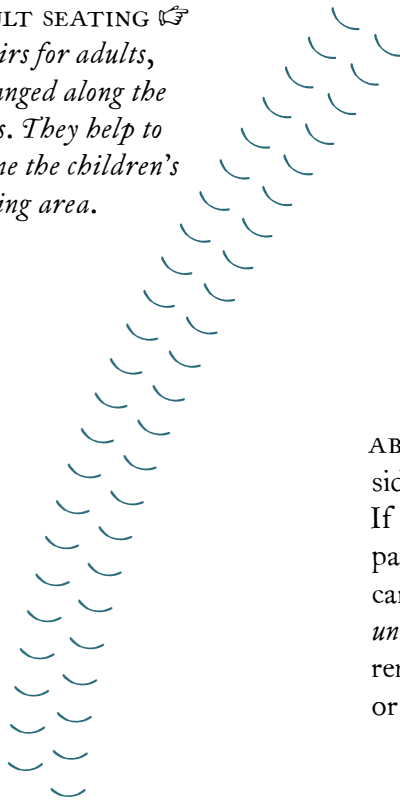


Seating plan for open areas

PERFORMANCE AREA

ADULT SEATING

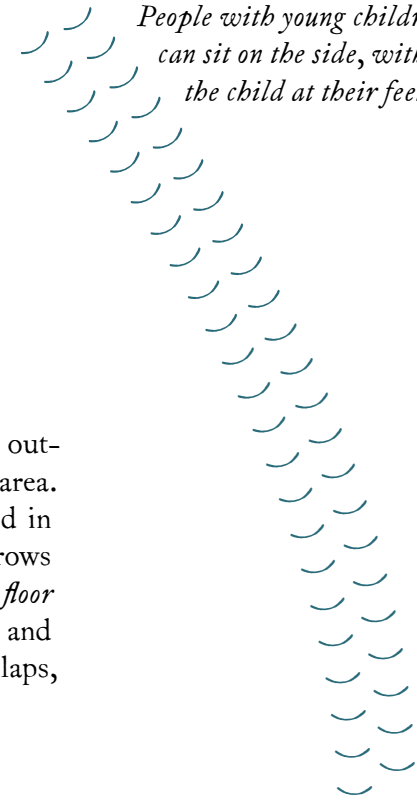
Chairs for adults, arranged along the sides. They help to define the children's seating area.



CHILDREN'S SEATING: Children should sit on the floor in this centre area. The children are asked to sit cross-legged, rather than kneeling or sitting up.

ABOUT CHAIRS: Chairs for adults can be arranged along the outside of the children's area, angled towards the performance area. If more chairs are needed for adults, chairs can be arranged in pairs along the sides, and if that isn't sufficient, one or two rows can be set out at the back. *All the children should sit on the floor unless they're too young to be on their own*—they'll see better, and remain more involved. Very young children should sit on laps, or on the floor with their parents seated nearby.

People with young children can sit on the side, with the child at their feet.
