

Rag & Bone

Finger puppet directions

1. Trace the pattern onto light cardboard (bristol board or a cereal box) or interfacing stabilizer (available at Fabricland as *Flexi-firm*).
2. Cut out the cardboard shape.
3. Cut carefully along the bottom of the arm from wrist a to armpit b.
4. Cut a slit from c to d. (You might need to reinforce the edges of this “buttonhole” with tape, if you’re using cardboard.)
5. Colour the rabbit with crayons (or markers if you’re using cardboard). Don’t forget the eyes, nose, mouth and whiskers!
6. Insert the button, e, into the c–d slit. The button becomes the tail, and the tube that you’ve just made is where to put your finger.
7. Enjoy!
